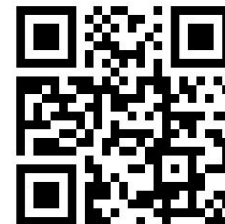


# BBES PTO After School Clubs

- Teacher-led club registration will open at **7 PM on Tuesday, September 24**. Registration links will appear on our website at exactly 7 PM that day. Selection will be on a first come, first served basis until spots are filled. We will be utilizing an online portal called Zeffy and you will pay at the time of signup. Please note you are **NOT** required to pay additional fees to Zeffy. If clubs don't meet the required minimum number of participants to run, you will be offered a second choice or will be refunded the club amount.
- Needs-based scholarships for teacher-led programs (only) are available on a limited basis. You must reach out to April Bowman at [adbowman@fcps.edu](mailto:adbowman@fcps.edu) **BEFORE registration opens on September 24** for a code to register. We will not be able to accommodate any scholarship requests after registration opens.
- Community-based club registration is run via each business website - some are open for sign-ups now.
- Clubs run for 8 sessions starting the week of October 7th and are held on days school is in session from 3:30-4:30 PM (unless otherwise noted).
